As of 6:00 P.M. yesterday, 79 countries have confirmed cases of the virus, including 221 cases in the United States. During a press conference this morning, March 6th, Governor Tom Wolf announced two presumed cases of coronavirus in Pennsylvania. The individuals are quarantined in Delaware and Wayne counties. We are actively monitoring the status of coronavirus and following recommended guidance as it is updated.
