Good Evening Families of Millersburg Area School District Students,

With the early closure of school ordered by Governor Wolf because of the COVID-19 crisis, it has been necessary to adjust how final grades will be calculated for the year. The district has decided to not grade work completed by students after the third quarter, which was ended on March 13, because students have different levels of access to the learning activities outlined in our Continuity of Education Plan. While the district encourages students to continue to work on the activities their teachers are making available for them so they can be prepared to start next year, final grades for this year will be the course average as it stood at the end of the third quarter. Course credit for high school students will be granted in full for all passed courses. Any student who has a final average of at least a 50% but not a passing grade of 65% will be afforded an opportunity to raise that average up to 65% by completing activities, assignments, or projects made available to them by their teachers between April 27 and May 22 for seniors and between April 27 and May 29 for underclassmen. The official end of the 2019-20 school year is May 29. Additional detail about this opportunity will be sent in a letter to parents of all students who fall into this category.
