Dear Millersburg Area School District Staff and Families:

In the interest of public safety using guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Pennsylvania Department of Health and Governor Tom Wolf, The Lenkerville Elementary School Talent Show, scheduled for Saturday, March 14, 2020, will be cancelled. The talent show rehearsal scheduled for this evening, Friday, March 13, 2020 will be cancelled as well.

Current guidance received from the Pennsylvania Department of Health states that gatherings of 250 or more individuals, occurring in the next two weeks, should be cancelled. Based on last year's attendance of this event, the number of 250 attendees is a possibility.

We will continue to monitor guidance as issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The District believes that a thoughtful and prudent approach is best as we stand committed to supporting public safety without unnecessary disruptions or panic. We will continue to provide regular updates as we work closely with federal, state, and local agencies and health officials. All official District updates and information regarding COVID-19 will be sent to you via our SchoolMessenger platform by email or phone. In order to protect the integrity of these communications, District updates will not be distributed via social media platforms such as Twitter or Facebook. The District encourages you to exercise caution and remain vigilant regarding the source and accuracy of information you may encounter on social media.
