

**MILLERSBURG-UPPER DAUPHIN AREA

This statement is being issued jointly by the Millersburg Area School District and Upper Dauphin Area School District. Late yesterday, the Upper Dauphin Area School District became aware of a confirmed case of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) affecting one of its student-athletes. The school district notified the Pennsylvania Department of Health and followed the guidance it received.

The student-athlete is quarantined and is recovering at home. The individual in question did have contact with other members of the Millersburg Area boys' soccer team within the past fourteen days. Those that were identified as potential close contacts have been notified by their respective school district.

The Millersburg Area School District and Upper Dauphin Area School District have extracurricular health and safety plans in place and those plans are being used by coaches as part of off-season workouts. The school districts have also been monitoring the increase of COVID-19 cases in the northern Dauphin County area, and that increase remains very low. The individual was not showing symptoms as of the last time that workouts were held.

On August 13, 2020, the Millersburg Area School District and Upper Dauphin Area School District announced that they were suspending extracurricular activities until August 31, 2020 due to a separate confirmed case on the Millersburg Area girls' soccer team. This newest case reaffirms that decision, as we remain committed to the health and safety of our students and staff as our top priority.
