While this is good news, we are asking our community for their assistance to slow the spread of COVID-19 by following all recommended precautions from the Department of Health.

The Millersburg Area Marching Band will continue to suspend all activities until August 31, 2020 in alignment with the announcement suspending all extracurricular athletic activities.

The Millersburg Area School District will continue to fully cooperate with the Pennsylvania Department of Health and monitor cases related to its schools. The health and safety of students and staff will remain our highest priority.
